




- Opened in 1980


Rhododendron ponticum

- 343.6 ha treated since 2020


Over fourteen people employed from the local area

















Invasive species management


Montbretia (*Crocosmia x crocosmiflora*) •

Montbretia Control - Connemara National Park





• 5 separate contractors








An tSeirbhís Páirceanna



- €1.9 million awarded in 2019


